Before me, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, personally appeared E. G. Aldridge, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is E. G. Aldridge and I am employed by the Town of Calera, Shelby County, Alabama, as its Water Works Superintendent, and I have been so employed for the past 28 years.

I am familar with the water system of the Town of Calera and the operation thereof and with the various water lines and water service lines which make up the water system, as owned and maintained by the Town of Calera.

Referring to a survey for Humble Oil Company prepared by Joseph A. Miller, Jr. dated May 15, 1969, and attached as Exhibit "A" to Utilities Easement from T. Edward Smith and wife, to Town of Calera, which is dated April 30, 1971, said Utilities Easement and said survey being attached to this affidavit so that all may be recorded simultaneously in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, I am familar with the property thereby shown and with the water lines shown thereon. The property is situated at the southeast intersection of Alabama Highway No. 25 (as it has been re-located) and Interstate Highway I-65.

The 6 inch water main which is shown on said survey to the south of the property shown and described on said survey, and extending from Point "X" to Point "Y" is a water main of the Town of Calera, and the 2 inch water line extending northerly from said 6 inch water main along the line from Point "Y" to Point "A" to Point "B" is also a water line of the Town of Calera. The 1 inch gas line extending from Point "C" to Point "D" also belongs to the Town of Calera.

The 8 inch sanitary sewer shown on said survey is a private sewer line serving the Clara-Neal Motel, which lies to the north



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of Alabama Highway No. 25.

The 3/4 inch water line shown on said survey as coming off of said 6 inch water main from Point "E" to Point "F" to Point "G" and changing to a 1/2 inch line from Point "G" to Point "H" was formerly in use and did formerly exist, as shown by said survey which was made on May 15, 1969, but said 3/4 inch water line and said 1/2 inch line have now been abandoned and are no longer in use and have not been in use for several months. The water service provided by the Town of Calera through said 3/4 inch water line was discontinued, and said 3/4 inch water lines were either removed or covered with fill dirt. In any event, this 3/4 inch water line cannot be found at the present time, and has been cut off, and is no longer claimed by the Town of Calera or anyone else.
