My name is Howard Payton. It has been called to my attention that my wife and I executed a Transmission Line Permit to Alabama Power Company on May 24, 1965, which is recorded in Deed Book 237 page 364 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and which described Lot 10 of Everette Subdivision as recorded in Map Book 4 page 70, Office of Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama. I have seen a copy of said map and I do not own any interest in said Lot 10 as shown by the map. and my wife, Eunice Payton I do own Lot 3 as shown by said map. There has also been called to my attention that James O. Douglas and wife executed a Transmission Line Permit to Alabama Power Company on May 25, 1965, recorded in Deed Book 237 page 347 in which Lot 3 was described. It would be my opinion that the Alabama Power Company in writing the permits put the wrong Lot number on each, as I know neither James O. Douglas nor his wife Jane Bishop Douglas have ever claimed any interest in the land which I own.

Said map of Everette Subdivision has never been recorded and when it shows Map Book 4 page 70, this is in error.
