
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
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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to LOUISVILLE AND NASHVILLE RAIL-ROAD COMPANY, a corporation created and existing under the laws of the State of Kentucky, hereinafter called Grantor, in hand paid by J. E. BEARDEN, hereinafter called Grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Grantor does remise, release and forever quit-claim to the Grantee, his heirs and assigns, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, all its right, title and interest in and to a strip or parcel of land at Helena, Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows:

A strip or parcel of land of various widths lying on each side of the center line of main track of the Acton Branch, Abandoned, of the Birmingham Division of the railroad of the Grantor at Valuation Station 21637+89, said point being in the north line of Buck Creek; thence extending in a general northerly direction with a width of one hundred (100) feet, lying fifty (50) feet on each side of said center line of Acton Branch, Abandoned, a distance of seventeen hundred ninety three (1793) feet, more or less, to a point in the section line between Sections fifteen (15) and ten (10), Township twenty (20) South, Range three (3) West; thence continuing in a general northerly direction with a width of sixty (60) feet lying thirty (30) feet on each side of said center line of main track a distance of fifty eight hundred twenty three (5823) feet, more or less, to the end of said right of way at Valuation Station 21714+05 and lying in the East one-half of Northeast quarter (E1/2 of NE1/4) of Section fifteen (15); the East onehalf of Southeast quarter (E1/2 of SE1/4) of Section ten (10); the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter (NW1/4 of SW1/4) and the Northwest quarter (NW1/4) of Section @leven (11), all in Township twenty (20) South, Range three (3) West, Shelby County, Alabama, and being part of the same property conveyed to the Grantor by the South and North Alabama Railroad Company by deed dated January 21, 1914, recorded in Deed Book 54, page 400, in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama.




