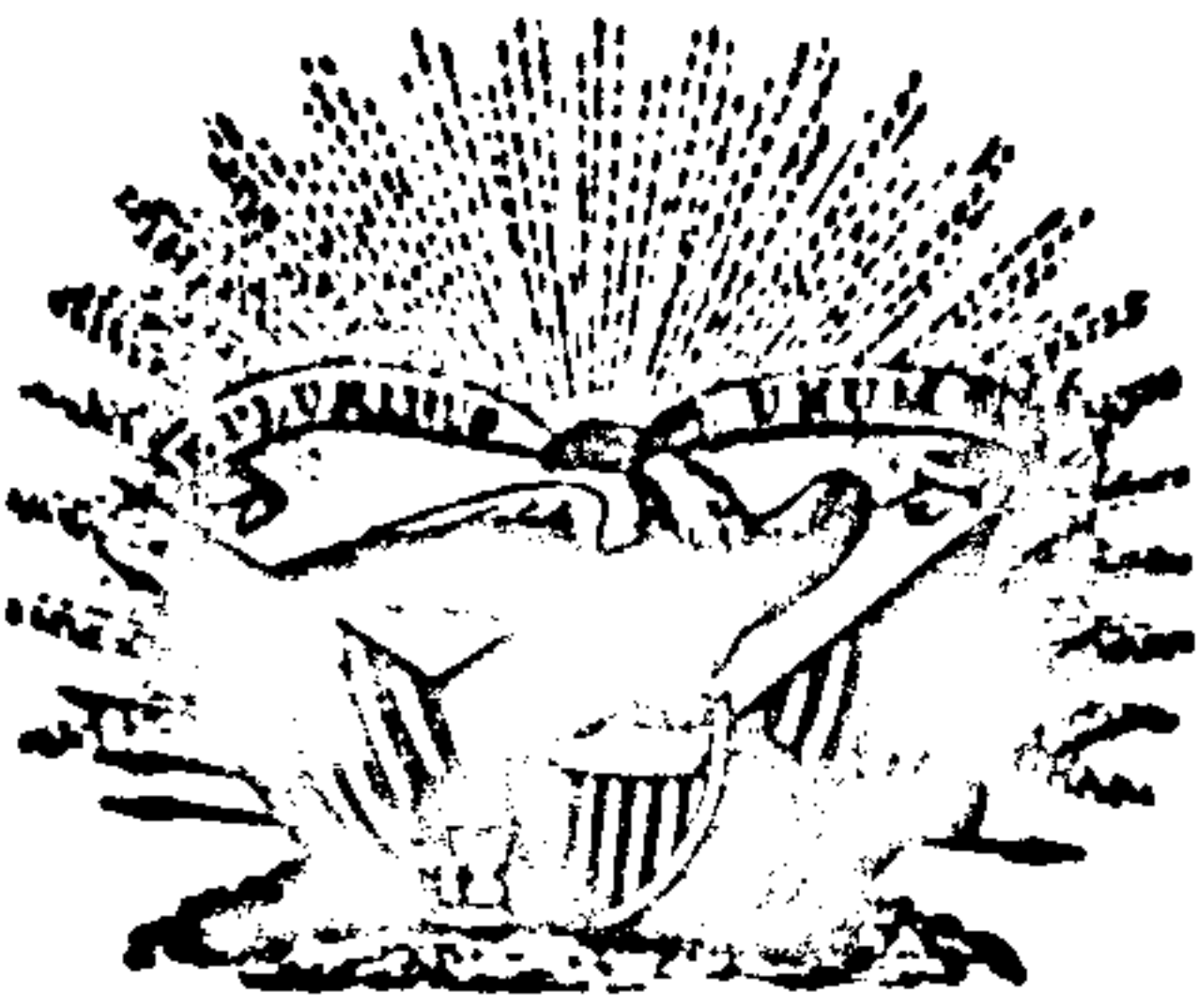


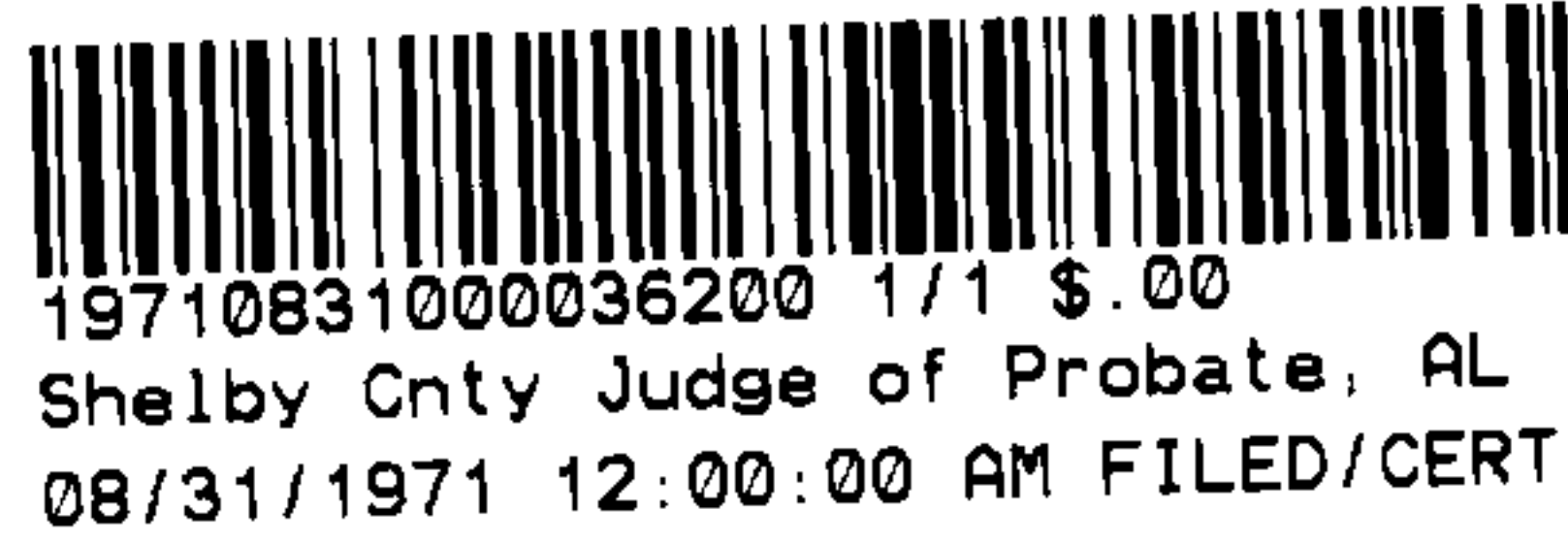


The United States of America.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 35792 for 80 acres,

issued in favor of *James Harrison private in Captain Levi's Company South Carolina Militia War 1812*



has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North East quarter of the South West quarter, and the North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section fourteen in Township twenty one of Range one West in the District of Sands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing Eighty acres and thirteen hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: *Which has been assigned to Henry M Collier*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

Henry M Collier

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Henry M Collier and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
