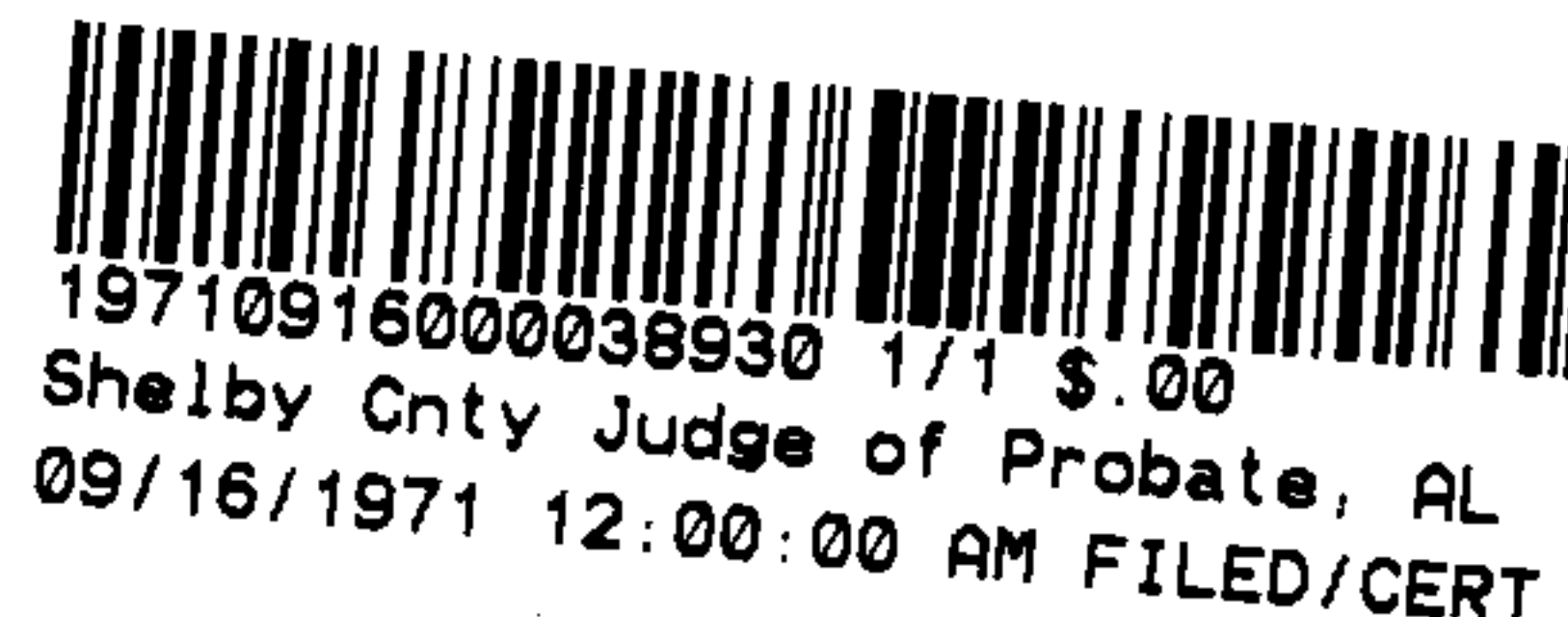


STATE OF ALABAMA

Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Britt Ingram, who, after being by me duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is Britt Ingram. I am 64 years of age and own certain land in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 21, Range 1 East lying West of the old Montgomery road which I purchased from Mamie Corn and others as shown by deed dated November 7, 1955, and recorded in Deed Book 177 page 455 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. It is called to my attention that in said deed, one line is described as follows: "thence South 50 deg. 41 min. West to the South line of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 11". Said line should be changed to read "thence South 50 deg. 41 min. East to the South line of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 11." The line referred to ran along an old fence which divided my land from the Corn land and said fence was there from the time I can first remember until I tore it down after I purchased said land from the Corns. I know that the error mentioned above was just a typographical error and I am very familiar with the way the line runs on the land I purchased from the Corns and know that the correct description is that as I have set out above. Since I purchased the Corn land in November, 1955, I have been in actual possession of it along with the land I owned South of the Corn land and all of it is in pasture where I keep cows and other animals. I have had it fenced in since I bought it and my cattle have run on it since 1955. In fact, I had it leased about 10 years before I purchased it. No one has ever disputed my title or possession of the same.
