I9' E 241.25 feet to the point of beginning, being a concrete marker on the south boundary of Shelby County Highway No. 22; thence South 88 deg. 01' E along this boundary 90.35 feet; thence South 36 deg. 37' E to a point on the West boundary of Shelby County Highway No. 17 a distance of 80 feet; thence South 14 deg. 47' W along this boundary 187.63 feet; thence North 89 deg. 50' West 165.13 feet; thence North 12 deg. 17' East 153.34 feet; thence South 86 deg.
