Before me, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, personally appeared Gerrie Thomas, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Gerrie Thomas. I am 27 years of age and reside at 3050 Nixon Road, S. E., Bessemer, Alabama.

I was formerly a member of The Benton Chapel Church of the Assembly of God located at Route 1, Maylene, Shelby County, Alabama, before said Church became inactive, my father having been a pastor of said Church while it was active.

At a special called meeting of the members and former members of said Church which was held at Route 1, Maylene, Shelby County, Alabama, on October 24, 1971, I was designated and elected to serve as Secretary of said meeting, said meeting having previously been called by the Trustees of said Church, namely, Robert L. Garner, Barber Hubbard, and Lester Jordan.

The members and former members of said Church had been informed in advance of said meeting, and of the time and place and purpose thereof, and said meeting was held on Sunday afternoon, October 24, 1971, at 2:30 P. M..

I did keep the minutes of said meeting, the original minutes of said meeting being attached to this affidavit as Exhibit "A" and by reference hereto made a part thereof.

As set forth in the minutes the membership did vote to authorize the Trustees of said Church to sell and convey the Church property, more particularly described as follows:

A part of the SE¼ of SE¼ of Section 5, Township 21 South, Range 4 West, described as follows: Commence at the SW corner of said quarter-quarter section and run North along West line to intersection with North line of Tuscaloosa Road; thence North 60 deg. 50 min. East along North boundary of said road 780 feet to SE corner of Lester Jordan 9½ acre tract for point of beginning; thence run North 210 feet; thence run Northeasterly and parallel with said road 420 feet; thence run South 210 feet to Tuscaloosa Road; thence run SW direction along said road 420 feet to point of beginning. Excepting highway right of way.

Minerals and mining rights excepted,
to Herman Eugene Peel for the sum of \$1,000.00. The sales price of \$1,000.00 was discussed at the meeting and was made known to those persons attending, and it was made clear at said meeting and to the members then attending that the real estate to be sold was the original parcel consisting of approximately 2 acres on which the Church building of the Benton Chapel Church of the Assembly Of God is situated, the legal description of said property being set forth above.

Minutes taken at the Meeting
to decide whether to sell or not to
sell Benton Chapell Church and surround-
ing two acres. Meeting took place on
Oct. 24, 1971 at 2:30 in Afternoon.

Minutes of Meeting
Meeting opened in prayer by Bro. Stuart
Bro James Thomas called meeting to
order. Bro. Robert Garner made motion to
call church into conference. Bro. T. T. Stuart
seconded motion.

Bro James Thomas explained the
purpose of the meeting, to vote on whether
to sell Benton Chapells Assembly of God
Church or not to sell it. And that the
money recieved from the sell was to
be used to brick the Siloah Baptist
Church which is now the Community
Church.

The property is to be sold to Herman
Eugene Peel.

A standing vote was taken. there
were seventeen in favor, and no one opposed.
Bro. Robert Garner asked each voter to sign
a paper stating whether they were for or
against the sell of Church and Property.



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The papers were passed around for everyone present to sign their choice.

Bro. Robert Garner thanked everyone for attending the meeting and for their concern for the community and the church.

Bro. Garner made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded by Bro T.T. Stewart. Meeting was closed.
