WHEREAS, there is an unrecorded map of the Town of Calera, Alabama, made by J. H. Dunstan of said Town of Calera, Alabama, and

WHEREAS, Edward Roberson and wife, Irene Roberson, are the owners of that part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, lying South of the Southern Railroad right-of-way, containing 8 acres, more or less, which said land is abutting certain allies and portions of certain streets and avenues, hereinafter described, as shown by said survey, which are sought to be vacated, and

WHEREAS, we, Edward Roberson and wife, Irene Roberson, desire to and do now declare the following described allies and portions of certain streets and avenues, as shown by said survey, which abut our said land, to be vacated, said allies and portions of said streets and avenues hereby declared vacated being described as follows:

That part or portion of Second Street and Third Street, according to J. H. Dunstan's unrecorded map of the Town of Calera, Alabama, which lie South of the Southern Railroad right-of-way and North of the South line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama. Situated in the Town of Calera, Alabama.

That part or portion of Thirteenth Avenue, according to J. H. Dunstan's unrecorded map of the Town of Calera, Alabama, which lies East of Fourth Street and is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama. WHEREAS, said property owned by us and said allies and portions of said streets and avenues hereby declared vacated lie and are situated within the corporate limits of the Town of Calera, Alabama;

WHEREFORE, petitioners do pray that the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Calera shall give their assent to such vacation and declare the above described allies and portions of streets and avenues vacated and to divest all public rights thereto, the said assent to be evidenced by a Resolution duly passed by the said Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Calera, Alabama.

EXCERPTS FROM MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF
CALERA, ALABAMA
HELD November 1, 1971

The Town Council of the Town of Calera, Alabama, convened at the Town Hall in the Town of Calera, Alabama, at 7:30pm clock on the 16th day of November, 1971 the regular time and place of meeting of said Town Council. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Arthur D. Davis. On roll call, the following answered pre-

The Mayor announced that quorum of the members of the Town Council were present and the meeting open for the transaction of business. The Minutes of the last meeting of the Town Council were read and approved as read.
