To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, James Wilson, of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama,

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at St. Stephens whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said James Wilson according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 2d of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the said tract, in the 10th District, of Range One West, in the District of Land in the State of Mississippi, containing eighty acres -

according to the official plan of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said James Wilson.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said James Wilson and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said James Wilson and to his heirs and assigns forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
