EXCERPTS OF MINUTES OF  
BETHEL BAPTIST CHURCH

A special conference was held by the Bethel Baptist Church on Sunday night, March 23, 1971, after the same had been announced at a prior meeting of the Church in accordance with its rules and regulations. The meeting was called to order by J. C. Armstrong, who served as Moderator.

Trustee of the Church, Luther Glenn reported that there had been an offer made to purchase the parsonage. Member Doyce Armstrong made a motion that the trustees be given authority to sell the parsonage for a sum of \$13,000.00, less expenses of sale, to Jack Atkins or such other person as he may designate. Said motion was seconded by Donna Morris. Upon roll call of the members present, all voted "Aye". Thereupon, the Moderator instructed the Trustees that they should proceed to consummate the sale of said property.
