In consideration of sixteen thousand and no/100 dollars (\$16,000.00) to the undersigned grantor, Martin Marietta Corporation, a corporation, (hereinafter called Grantor) in hand paid by Joseph DeMarco, Jr. (hereinafter called Grantee), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantor does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Grantee the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

> That part of the E 1/2 of SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 20, Range 3 West, which lies South and West of the right of way of A.B. & C. R.R. (now Seaboard Coast Line Railroad) and North and East of the old location of the public road leading from Pelham to Helena, Alabama, which road is called the Old Tuscaloosa Road.
