

QUITCLAIM DEED

A. D. McGuire and May McGuire to Superior Lime & Hydrate Company, Inc., and recorded in Deed Book 79, at page 16, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama:

Beginning at a point South 29 degrees East 634 feet from Northwest corner of SE-1/4 of SE-1/4 of Section 14, Township 20, Range 3 West; thence South 11 degrees 30' 537 feet; thence South 1 degree West 354 feet to the right of way of the Louisville & Nashville Railroad, North 57 degrees West along said right of way 28 feet; thence North 1 degree East 340.5 feet; thence North 11 degrees 30' West 557.8 feet; thence South 33 degrees East 32 feet to point of beginning being a railroad right of way from property line of the Superior Lime & Hydrate Co., Inc., through said S. A. D. McGuire's lands to the L & N Railroad Co. right of way.


