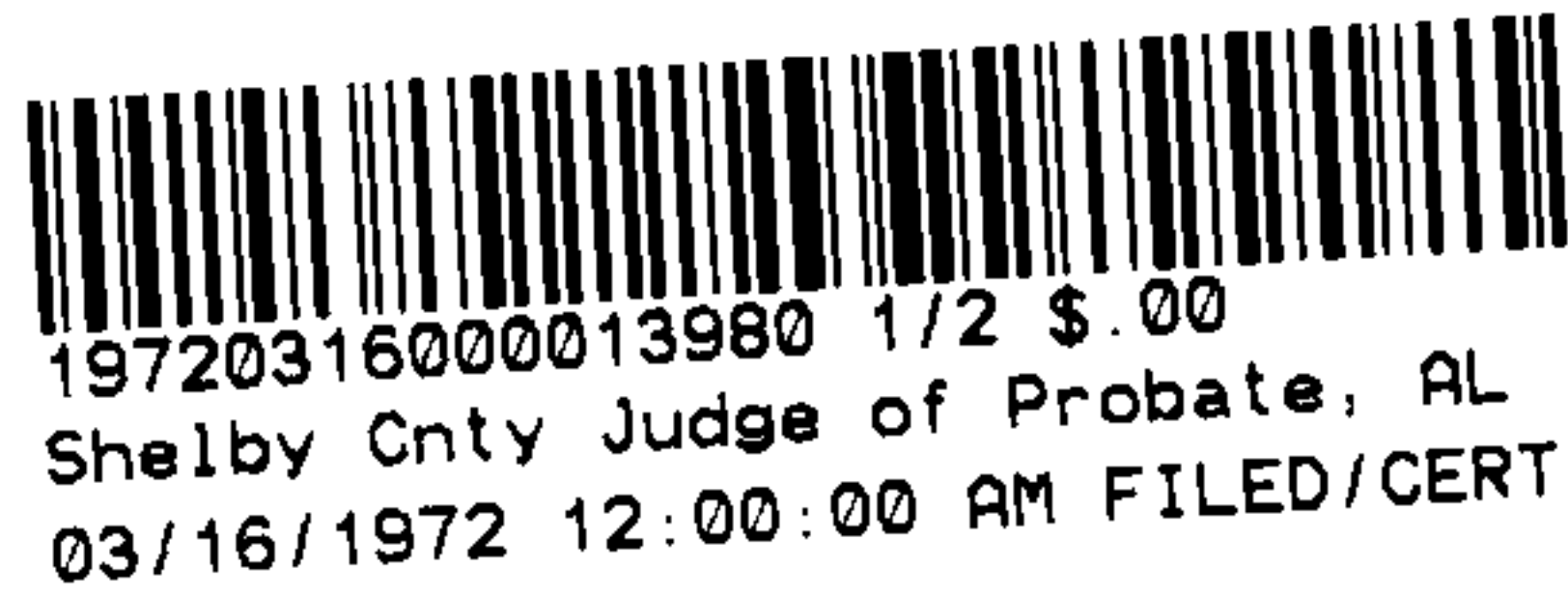

Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said state and county, personally appeared George F. Wooten, who, being by me duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am a son of Luther W. Wooten and Lummlie P. Wooten and am 57 years of age. My parents, the said Luther W. Wooten and Lummlie P. Wooten, purchased for a home in the approximate year 1943 the following described property lying and being in the Town of Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Lot Five (5), Block "D", Lyman's Addition to the Town of Montevallo, Alabama, according to plat recorded in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, in Map Book 3 at page 27.

Immediately after my said parents purchased this property, they moved upon the same as their home and lived upon said property continuously and without interruption from the time of the purchase until the death of my father in March of 1970. My mother continued to reside upon this property until September of 1971, at which time she removed from the property for health reasons. Since September, 1971, my sister and I have continued to keep the utilities, except the telephone, connected, have inspected the property from time to time, have had the property cleaned, have gathered pecans from the trees located upon this property and have otherwise exercised general possession over the property.

In addition to the possession of my parents and family, above recited, there is a garage apartment located upon said property which my parents and the estate of my father have rented to students at the University of Montevallo over a long period of years.
