

There is called to my attention a deed from Lee Byers and wife. The said Lee Byers/died in 1942 without leaving a Will and the said Raney Byers, my step-grandmother, died in 1946. Affiant further says that the said Raney Byers and Lourenia Byers were one and the same person, the name Raney, just being a short name for Lourenia. There is called to affiant's to Frank Alexander and wife Lillie J. Alexander attention a deed from Lee Byers and wife, Lourenia Byers/dated October 17, 1930, and recorded in Deed Book 89, page 213 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and she is familiar with the land covered in said deed. The Alexanders still live on their lot and I know the same lies a considerable distance due North of the above described land. There is called to my attention a deed from Harold A. Rubin and wife, to Clarence Littly dated July 23, 1959, and recorded in Deed Book 213, page 398 in the Probate office of Shelby County, Alabama, I do not know the exact dimensions of the Lilly property or the Daniels property, but I do know that the Lilly property lies immediately north of the above described Williams property and that the Daniels property lies North of and adjoins the Lilly property. all the years I have never known of anyone disputing the possession or contesting the title of John Ehperiam Williams and Odessa Williams and their predecessors in tit le.
