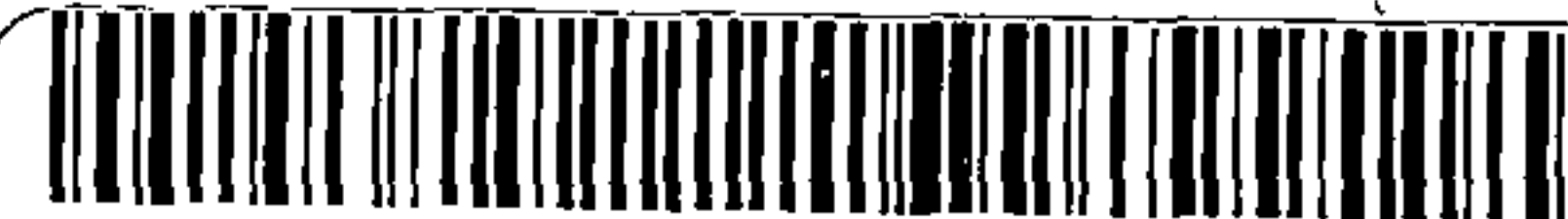

Before me, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Dorothy D. Ervin, who first being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

That she is one of the surviving children of Roston S. Eddings, Sr., who died intestate and without administration in Oct. of 1953. He left surviving him his widow, and my mother, and two other children, being Roston S. Eddings, Jr. and Kathleen DeJuren. On April 29, 1970, my mother died also intestate and there has been no administration of her estate.

There were no other children born of the marriage between my mother and father, and therefore, are no deceased children of theirs nor any children of deceased children.

Since the death of both my parents, I have never known of any claims for debts or liens of any nature against the unadministered estate of either my father or my mother.

Subsequent to the death of my mother and father, my sister, brother and I divided, by deed, the approximately 58 acres owned by my father in Shelby County, Alabama, which property is described as follows:

The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and all the part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama lying West of the right-of-way of Montevallo-Siluria Paved Highway, containing 58.3 acres, more or less.

All of the surviving persons mentioned in this affidavit constitute all of the heirs at law of Roston S. Eddings, Sr. and those of his deceased wife and all of which are over the age of twenty-one years and are of no legal disabilities.

The purpose of this affidavit is to induce Lawyers Title Insurance Corporation to issue its Title Policy to Shelby Enterprises, Inc., under its case no. S-3534.
