This acknowledges receipt of your letter of March 10, 1972, regarding a parcel of property located in Shelby County and described as: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 22, Range 2 West.

I checked the records and find that this property did sell to the State in 1930 for 1929 Ad Valorem Taxes. The property is still on record from this sale.

I find that the property sold again in 1933, however, the property was sold by the State to George Harris on August 2, 1937. It is my opinion that the deed issued in 1937 from the later sale would also clear the property for the tax sale of 1930.
