WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR - AMERICAN TITLE INS. CO., Birmingham, Alabama

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, *See Meg. 328-344*

That in consideration of Twelve Thousand and no/100 *2585* DOLLARS

to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we,  
**John H. Boaz and wife, Lorene Boaz**  
(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
**Norman Resch and Mildred Resch**

(herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Commence at the NE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, Township 21 South, Range 1 East; thence run West along the North line of said quarter-quarter section a distance of 820.47 feet, to the West right of way of the Columbiana-Kingdom Highway, and the point of beginning; thence continue West along the North line of said quarter-quarter section a distance of 274.92 feet; thence turn an angle of 139 deg. 06 min. to the left and run a distance of 416.51 feet; thence turn an angle of 90 deg. 00 min. to the left and run a distance of 180.00 feet, to the West right of way of said highway; thence turn an angle of 90 deg. 00 min. to the left and run along the West line of said highway a distance of 208.71 feet, to the point of beginning.
