of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated
in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

A part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, more particularly described as follows: Commence at the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, and run North for a distance of 653.40 feet, thence turn an angle to the left of 88° 46' and run West a distance of 432.0 feet to the point of beginning of lot herein conveyed; continue West along said course for a distance of 75.0 feet to the NE corner of Mauldin property, thence turn left and run South along the Mauldin property line for a distance of 163.0 feet to the SE corner of said Mauldin property, thence turn an angle to the left of 88°35' and run East for a distance of 75.0 feet, thence turn an angle to the left of 91° 25' and run North for a distance of 163.23 feet to the point of beginning.

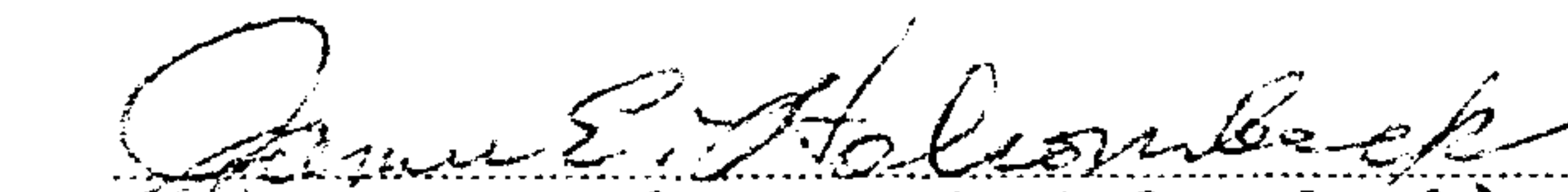
