TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE ACRES, being one hundred and fifteen acres of Township Twenty One Range One East in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing Seventeen acres and one hundred and fifteen acres.

ordering to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Hukem Hardesty*, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Hukem Hardesty*, the said tract above described; To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said *Hukem Hardesty*, his heirs and assigns, forever.
