Admiral Edmund King of Wholly County

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Shreveport*

whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said **Edmund King**,

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the *Public Lands*, for

the most part of the north east quarter of section eleven, township two, of Range three, in *Wholly County*, in the State of

Mississippi and State of Texas containing seventy three acres, and seventy eight hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-

chased by the said **Edmund King**

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several

acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said **Edmund King**

the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-

tenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said **Edmund King**

and *his* heirs and assigns forever.
