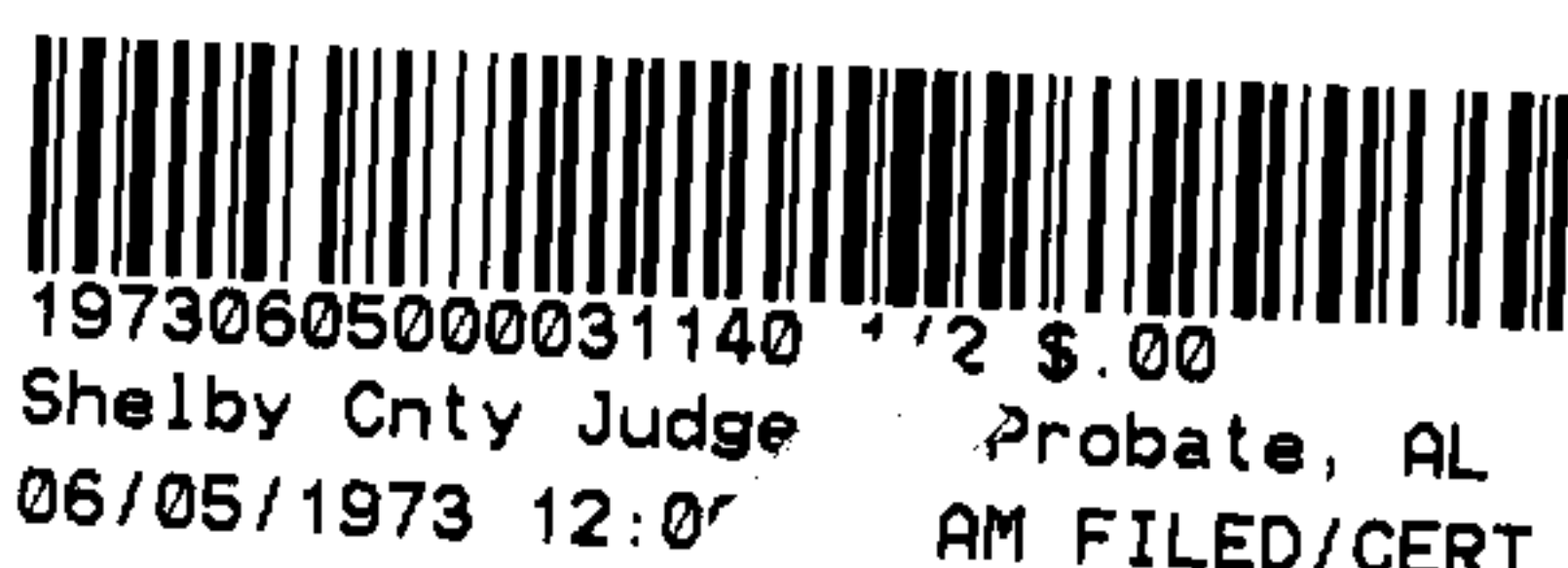
do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said A. F. Dodson Jr. and wife, Norma G. Dodson

Run thence East along said forty line a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning. Turn thence North run 265 feet to a point, thence turn East and run 200 feet to a point, Thence turn South and run a distance of 265 feet to said quarter section line. Thence turn West along quarter section line 200 feet to point of beginning.

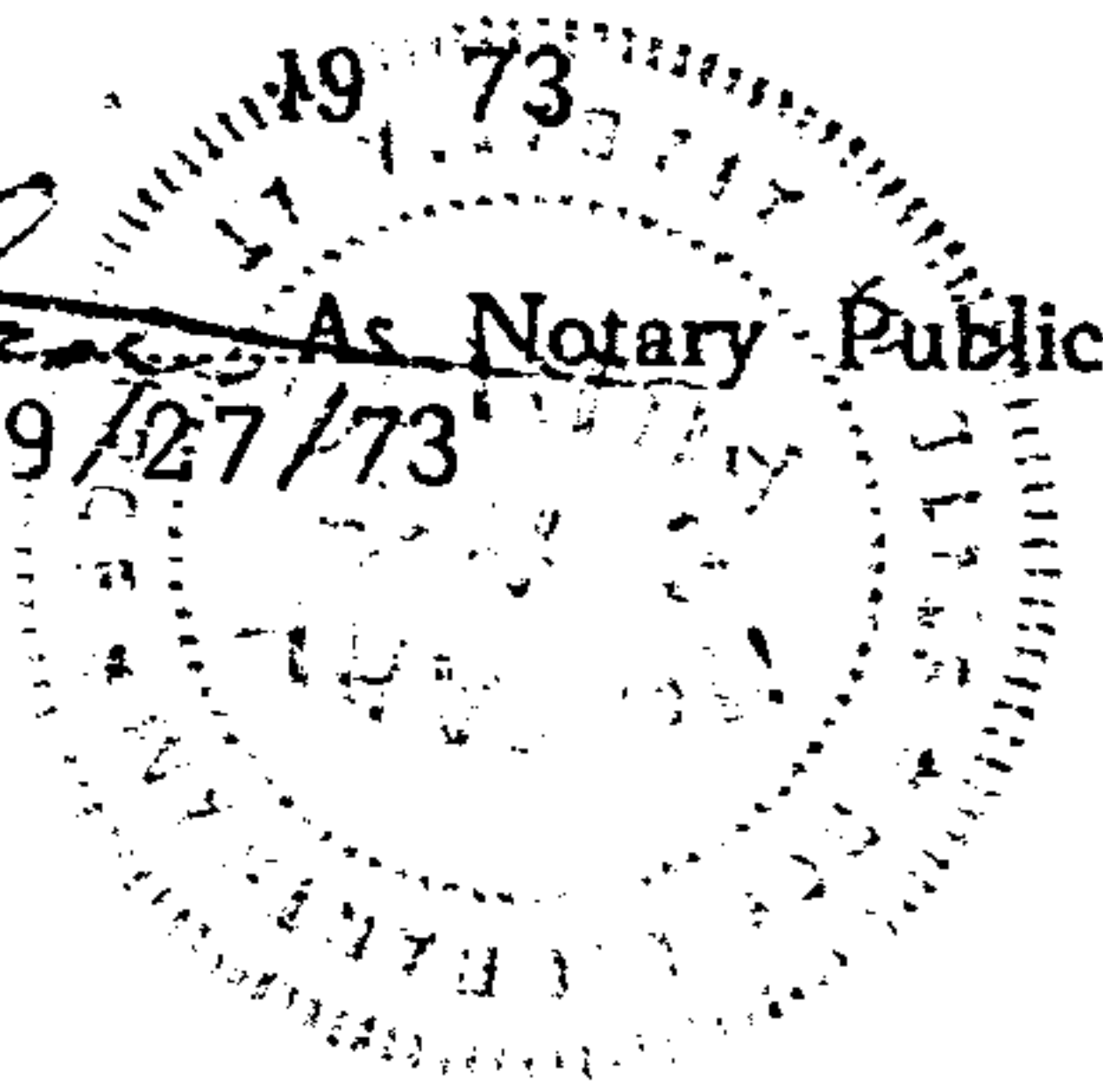
