KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT:

WHEREAS, heretofore on, to-wit: December 29, 1970,  
H. H. Burgess and wife, C. A. Burgess,  
mortgagors, executed a certain mortgage to John S. Carothers and  
Blanch R. Carothers, which said

did offer for sale and sell at public  
outcry, in front of the Main entrance of the Court  
House at Columbiana, Shelby County,

WHEREAS, the highest and best bid obtained for the property
