Whereas *William Osley*, of *Shelby County, Alabama*has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Tuscaloosa* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

William Osley, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter of the North East quarter, the West half of the South East quarter and South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section twenty one, in Township twenty one, of Range two, West in the District of Lands, Subject to sale at *Tuscaloosa, Alabama*, containing one hundred and sixty acres, and thirteen hundredths of an acre.

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracts have been purchased by the said *William Osley*.

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

William Osley,

and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *William Osley*,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
