Whereas, Edmund Steing of Shelby County, Alabama, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Mardisville, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Edmund Steing, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the fractional of a section thirty, in fractional township nineteen, of range three, east, in the district of lands subject to sale at Mardisville, Alabama, containing forty nine acres, and forty hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Edmund Steing.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Edmund Steing, and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature therunto belonging, unto the said Edmund Steing, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
