Whereas John Dawson Secor of Alabama, petitioner, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a duplicate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Dawson Secor according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 28th of April, 1880, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the lot or fraction of fractional section and unimproved land of Range Three East in the District of Land Subject to Sale at Auction in Alabama containing thirty-eight acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said John Dawson Secor, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said John Dawson Secor, that the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the said several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said John Dawson Secor, all the rights, privileges, immunities and advantages of whatever nature, heretofore belonging unto the said John Dawson Secor, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
