A right of way for ingress and egress and installation of public utilities 30 feet in width, the centerline of which is more particularly described as follows: For point of beginning commence at a point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 1 East, where the South boundary line of U. S.
