That in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 (\$10.00) Dollars, and other good and valuable consideration to the undersigned grantor,

TRANS-WORLD ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation, in hand paid by COLONIAL FINANCIAL SERVICE, INC., an Alabama corporation, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said G.A.C. TRANS-WORLD ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said COLONIAL FINANCIAL SERVICE, INC. the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama and being:

Begin at the Northeast corner of NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 21, Range 3 West, run South along East boundary of said Quarter-Quarter Section for a distance of 1154.55 feet; thence run West 103.71 feet for the point of beginning of the land herein described; thence continue West 105 feet to a street; thence North 210 feet; thence East 105 feet; thence South 210 feet to the point of beginning, which is a part of Lots 1 and 3 in the L.E.
