to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we,

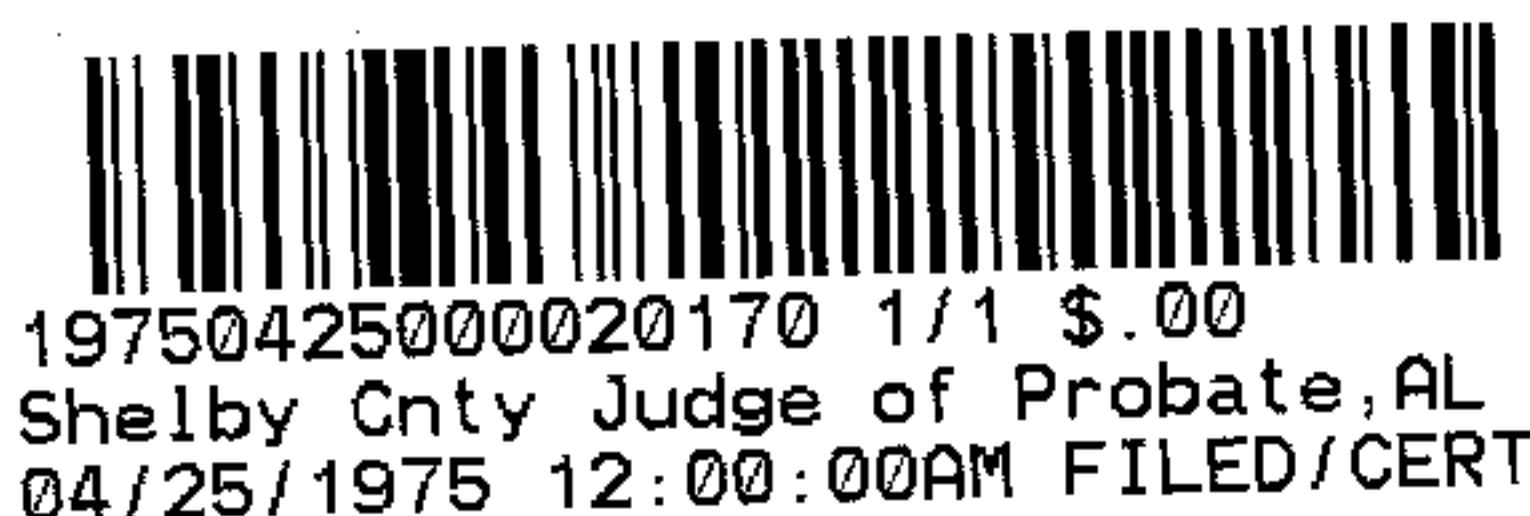
Bertha P. Kennedy and husband, Robert T. Kennedy
