(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

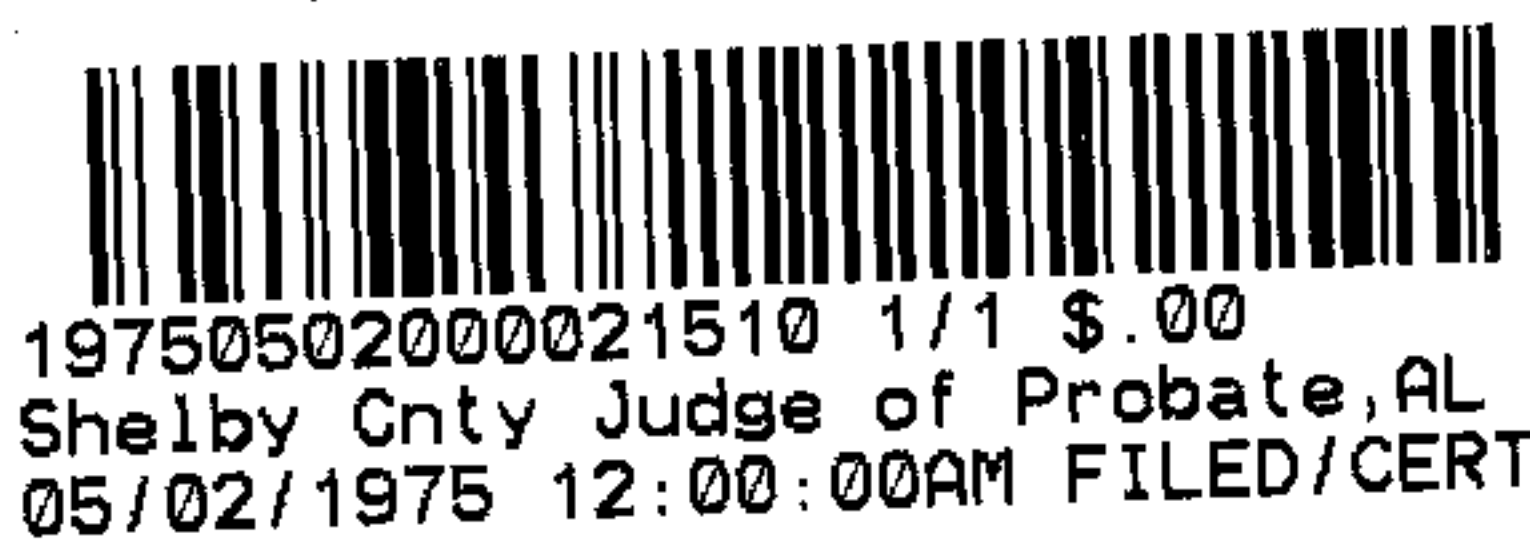
Manuel L. Brocato and Doris S. Brocato
