That in consideration of Six Thousand and No/100 (\$6,000.00)-----Dollars


to the undersigned grantor (whether one or more), in hand paid by the grantees herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, I or we, Peggy Payne Baker and husband, James Edgar Baker; Willie Mae Payne Vest and husband, Herman Brantley Vest; Mary Lou Payne Reh, a widow; and Phillip J. Payne and wife, Shirley Payne

(herein referred to as grantor, whether one or more), grant, bargain, sell and convey unto John Payne Baker

(herein referred to as grantees, whether one or more), the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

A lot or parcel of land situated in the Town of Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama, and known as the Thomas Lynch lot, being the lot bought by the said Thomas Lynch from R. W. Nolen and located between the lot known as the C. C. Wells lot and Shoals Creek, bounded on the West by the Old Depot Road leading to the Montevallo Depot, now called the Montevallo and Selma Road, subject to easements and rights of way of record.

The grantors warrant that said property was formerly owned by their father, George F.
