the party of the first part has granted, bargained and sold, and does by  
these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the

The southeast quarter of northeast quarter (SE 1/4 of  
NE 1/4), Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 1 West,  
Shelby County, Alabama.


Subject to any existing easements for public roads,

This conveyance shall be considered as a quitclaim with  
regard to mineral and mining rights in and to the above  
described land.

tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in  
anywise appertaining, unto the party of the second part, her heirs and  
assigns, forever.

And the party of the first part does hereby covenant with the party

that said premises are free from encumbrances except as stated herein;  
and that it warrants and will forever defend the title to said premises  
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
