
DEED OF GIFT

Whitfield, an unmarried man, hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto my said daughter, Lounell W. Brasher, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

One lot of land described as follows: Beginning at the SW corner of the NW-1/4 of NW-1/4 of Section 12, thence run North 157-1/4 yards, thence East 157-1/4 yards, thence South 157-1/4 yards to land line, thence West along line to point of beginning, lying in and being a part of Section 12, Township 18, Range one East, but reserving and excepting to the grantor a life estate in and to said property.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said Lounell W. Brasher, her heirs and assigns forever.

Brasher, her heirs, executors and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons except as hereinabove set forth.
