Minerals and mining rights excepted.

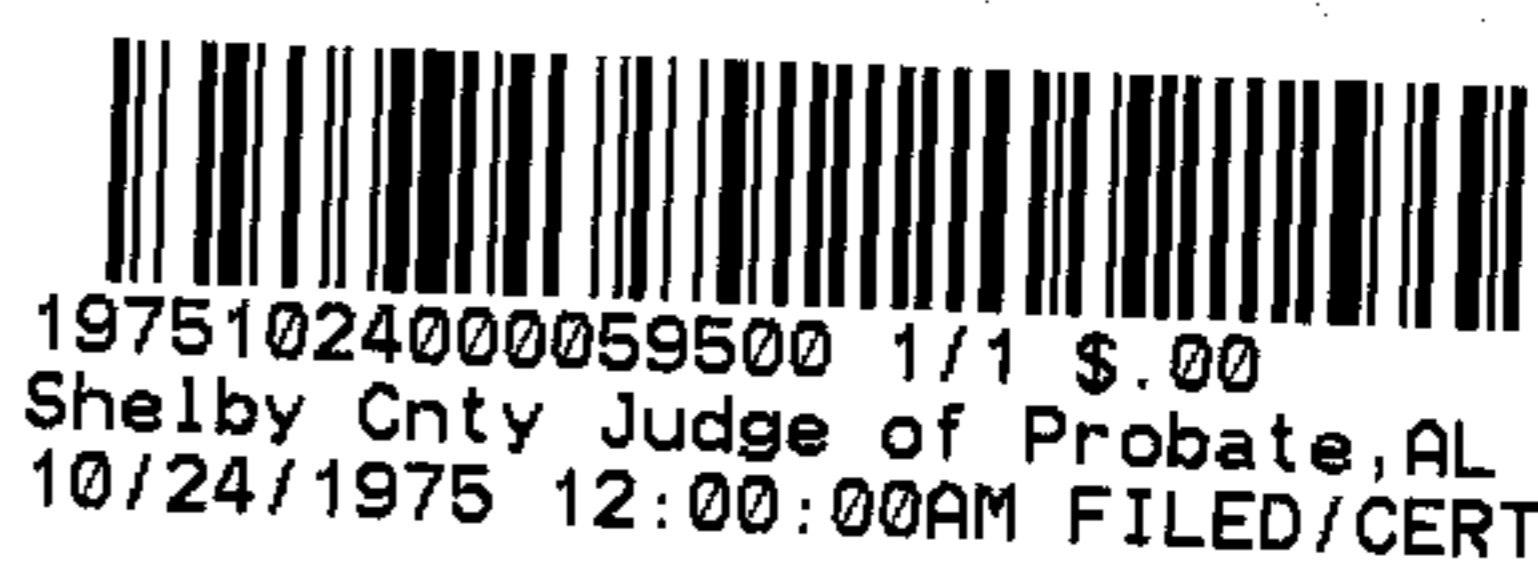
