SCHMIDT, FRED B. FROMHOLD, H. JAMES SHEETZ, JOHN M. SCHUBERT and MORTON D. BOHN, JR., Trustees under Declaration of Trust dated April 15, 1970 (herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto ROBERT SCIASCIA and wife SUSAN SCIASCIA
