AMENDMENT OF DECREE

Begin at a point 210 feet south of the southeast corner of the $NW_{2}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of Section 17, Township 19, Range 1 West, as located on Exhibit "A" and designated as point "A", said point "A" being the point of intersection of an established fence with the east line of said quarter-quarter section; thence run in a westerly direction along said fence line approximately 830 feet to point "B"; thence run in a southwesterly direction a distance of 140.0 feet, more or less, along a fence line to point "C" said point "C" being located 330 feet south of the south line of $NW_{2}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $SE_{2}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of said Section 17, Township 19, Range 1 West; thence run west and parallel with said south line of said quarter-quarter section and parallel with the south line of $NE_{2}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of Section 17, Township 19, Range 1 West a distance of 520 feet, more or less, to point "D" on said survey, said point "D" being located on the east line of said U. S. Highway 280, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

All other things in said decree are hereby ratified and confirmed.
