When I first knew said property it was in the possession of my mother and father, E. L. and Flora Etress and they were farming the same, and had it in cultivation; he farmed it and cultivated the above described property for each and every year from 1932 up to the time he sold the same to W. A. Henke and wife, Ola Henke, or perhaps a year, or so, prior to the Henke sale. During the period of time from 1932 up until the property was sold to Mr. and Mrs. Henke, in addition to cultivating and farming the property each and every year, my father had had, and maintained a fence around said property for each and every year.
