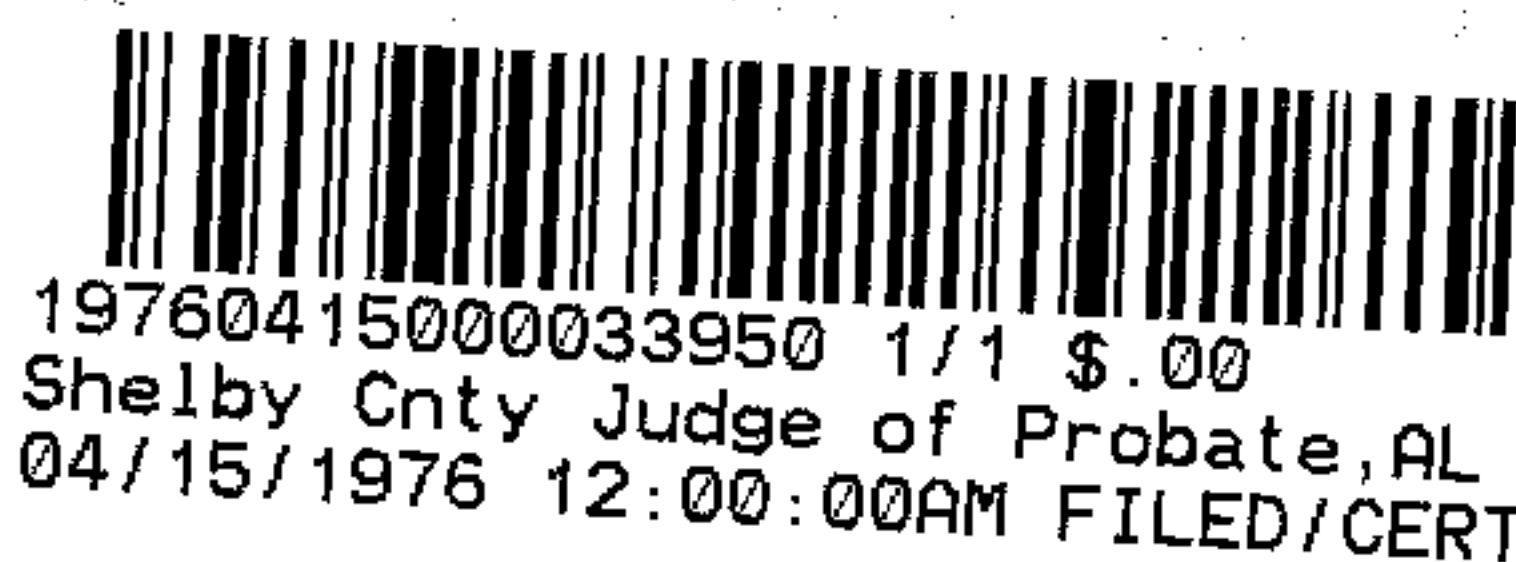
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Navajo West, Inc.
