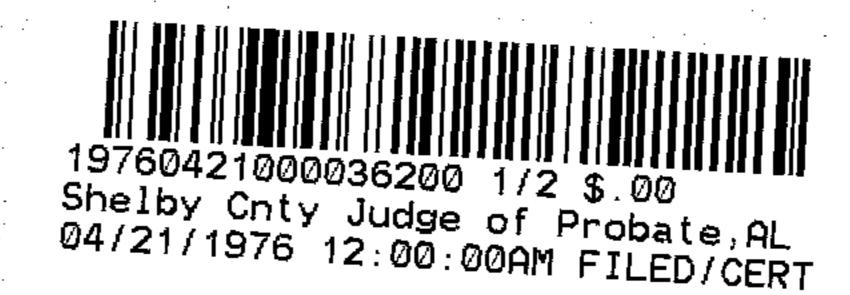

And the party of the first part does hereby covenant with the party of the second part that it is lawfully seized in fee of the said premises, that it has a good right to sell and convey the same; that said premises are free from encumbrances except as stated herein; and that it warrants and will



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forever defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
