KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That,

WHEREAS, heretofore, on to-wit: January 3, 1974, Carl Applequist and wife, Avis Applequist, Mortgagors, executed a certain mortgage to Real Estate Financing, Inc., a corporation, which said mortgage is recorded in Book 336, page 469, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and



WHEREAS, on July 2, 1976 the day on which the foreclosure sale was due to be held under the terms of said notice during the legal hours of sale, said foreclosure was duly and properly conducted, and the said Federal National Mortgage Association, a corporation as transferee of said mortgage, did offer for sale and sell at public outcry, in front of the Main entrance of the Court- house of Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, the property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the highest and best bid obtained for the property described in the aforementioned mortgage was the bid of Federal National Mortgage Association, a corporation, in the amount of (\$11,761.32) ELEVEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY ONE DOLLARS and 32/100 Dollars which sum was offered to be credited on the indebtedness secured

Subject to the Statutory right of redemption on the part of those entitled to redeem under the laws of the State of Alabama.


