Along with the sale of the property to Mr. Higginbotham, I hereby sell all of the contents of the house to Warren G. Findley. Mr. Findley can remove the Piano at his will or when he gets ready. I understand that Mr. Findley will change the locks on the house and keep it secure forme in case I am able to get out of the Nursing Home and go home; he is to keep all of the keys and I can pick up one when I go home. This instrument will act as a receipt for the money paid to me for my home in Calera and its entire contents; 4,500.00. Dated this 26th day of February, 1974.
