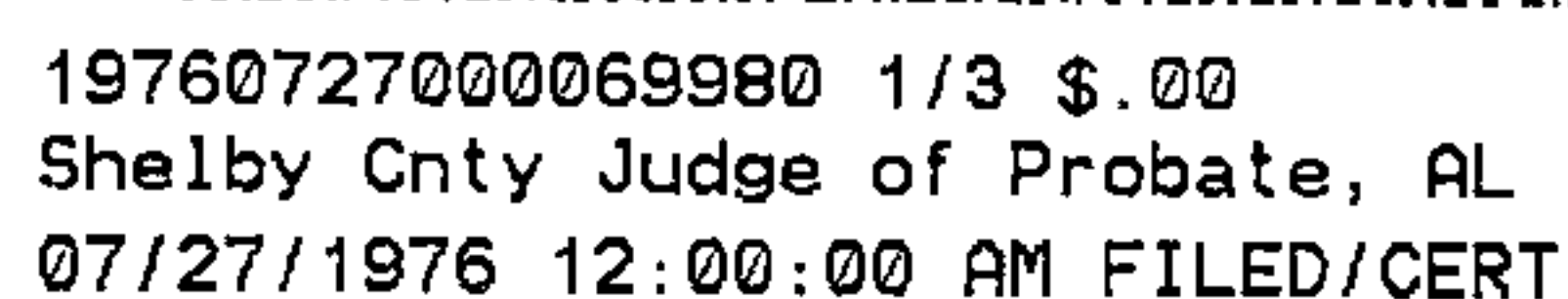

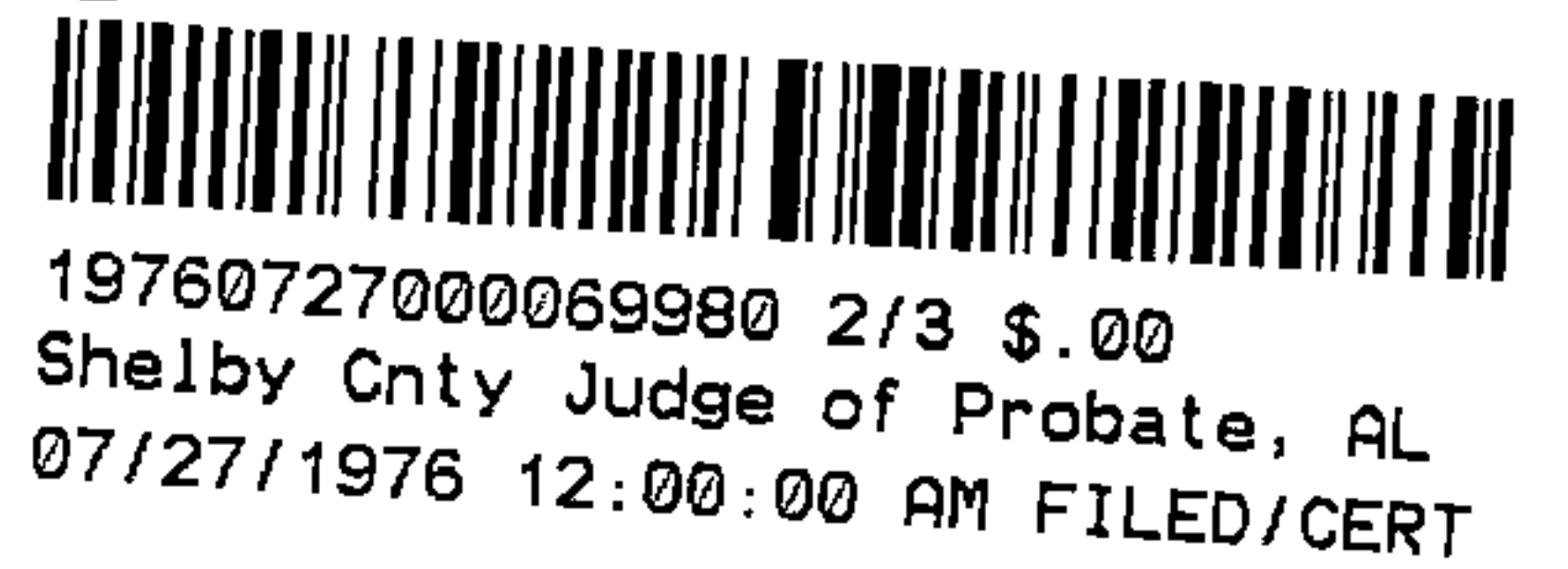

A part of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said section for the point of beginning; thence run South along the West line of said quarter-quarter section for a distance of 487.64 feet to the Northwest corner of Monte Tierra Subdivision, Shelby County, Alabama; thence turn an angle of 89 degrees 10 minutes to the left and run east along the north boundary of said subdivision for a distance of 1931.50 feet to the west right of way of Alabama Highway 119; thence turn an angle of 79 degrees 23 minutes to the left and run along said right of way for a distance of 214.16 feet; thence turn an angle of 2 degrees 49 minutes to the right and continue along said right of way for a distance of 214.83 feet to the north line of said section 34; thence turn an angle of 101 degrees 30 minutes to the left and run west along said north line for a distance of 2029.10 feet to the point of beginning. LESS AND EXCEPT the following two parcels:

A part of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows:
PARCEL I.:

Commence at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section and run South along the West boundary of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section for a distance of 487.64 feet; thence turn an angle of 89 degrees 10 minutes to the left and run East for a distance of 1799.04 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue along the last described line for a distance of 132.46 feet to the West right of way of Alabama Highway No. 119; thence turn an angle of 79 degrees 23 minutes to the left and run Northeasterly along said right of way for a distance of 171.05 feet to the beginning point of a curve, concave to the Southwest and having an interior angle of 80 degrees 21 minutes and a radius of 15.0 feet; thence run Northeasterly, Northerly Northwesternly and Westerly along said curve for an arc length of 21.03 feet to the ending point of said curve; thence run Westerly along the tangent of said curve for a distance of 143.74 feet; thence turn an angle of 90 degrees 30 minutes to the left and run South for a distance of 133.36 feet to the point of beginning.

Commence at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section and run East along the North boundary of said Section for a distance of 1307.10 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue along the last described line for a distance of 222.00 feet to the West right of way of Alabama Highway No. 119; thence turn an angle of 101 degrees 30 minutes to the right and run Southwesterly along said right of way for a distance of 154.07 feet to the beginning point of a curve, concave to the Northwest and having an interior angle of 100 degrees 28 minutes and a radius of 25.0 feet; thence run Southwesterly and Westerly along said curve for an arc distance of 43.48 feet to the ending point of said curve; thence run Westerly along the tangent of said curve for a distance of 149.17 feet; thence turn an angle of 89 degrees 02 minutes to the right and run Northerly for a distance of 183.36 feet to the point of beginning.
