That in consideration of Two Thousand Eight Hundred and no/100-----DOLLARS

to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we, William A. Parker, III and wife, Judi W. Parker

(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Claude Stuteville and wife, Paula Stuteville

(herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

A tract of land located in the Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter of Section 18 - Township 21 South - Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama more particularly described as follows:

Commence at a point on the Northeast line of Lot 1, Block 1, Parker's Subdivision as recorded, said point being five feet Northwest of the most Easterly corner of said lot, thence looking Northwesterly along said lot line, turn 84°19' right Northeasterly 75.73' to the point of a curve to the right, said curve being subtended by a central angle of 40°00' and having a radius of 348.33 feet, thence around the arc of said curve 243.13 feet to the point of tangent, thence along said tangent 7.09 feet to the point of beginning of tract of land herein described, thence continue along said tangent 108.65 feet, thence 90°18'30" left Northerly 279.74 feet, thence 90°00' left Westerly 107.2 feet, thence 89°42'10" left Southerly 279.15 feet more or less to the point of beginning.
