In addition to the obligation set forth in the original purchase agreement, and as a part of the consideration for such agreement, the Company further agrees, providing there are no installment payments in arrears on the original purchase, that in the event of the death of an unmarried child or children of the purchaser, between the ages of birth and 21 years who is living at the date of the execution of the purchase agreement above referred to, or in the event of the death of an unmarried child or children between the ages of birth and 21 years born to said purchaser after the date of the execution of the purchase agreement referred to above, it will provide for such child or children free of charge:

1. Bronze Memorialization
2. Opening and Closing Fee
3. Interment Space* Yes
4. Other

*Whenever possible, such space shall be adjacent to the spaces originally selected by the husband and wife, but if such additional space adjacent to the spaces previously selected is not available, then the Company shall provide an equivalent number of grave spaces if available in another part of the Cemetery, provided the purchaser reconveys to the Company the grave spaces originally purchased.

Should the purchaser die before his or her child, and the surviving spouse elects to avail himself or herself of the aforementioned offer of the Company but is unable to obtain an adjacent grave for the child, so that it is necessary to substitute grave spaces elsewhere in the cemetery, the surviving spouse must pay the costs incident to disinterment and reinterment.

It is hereby certified that on the reverse side are the correct names and dates of birth of the children of the purchaser, who to the best of his or her knowledge are in good health. Any additional children born to purchaser are covered by this agreement if and when their names are added to the list of other children set out on the reverse side hereof.
