My name is Emma Dell Higginbotham. I recall when my mother and father purchased the hereinafter described land from Robert C. Mosley and Lena Mosley in February of 1957. I also recall that my mother went ahead with the arrangements to have the property surveyed and she and my father hired J. R. McMillan, a Registered Land Surveyor, to survey the property. I recall that they had him to put up stakes at each corner and that he hired two other men to help him with the survey. Since that time, I know the County obtained a right-of-way deed from my parents and constructed a new road adjoining the property and the same is now paved. Since the time they purchased said property, they have been in actual possession of same, claim to own it and have paid taxes each and every year. In fact, I write their checks and have paid their taxes for them each and every year. I have never heard of anyone disputing their title or possession since they purchased the property in 1957. Said land is described as:
