Situated in Shelby County to-wit: The Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ and Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 18, Range 2 East.

Less and except one acre described as follows: Begin at the Northwest Corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, Township 18, Range 2 East, thence East $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the starting point, thence East 210 feet to a point, thence South 210 feet to a point, thence West 210 feet to a point, thence North 210 feet to starting point.

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The above Grantors and Grantees constitute all the heirs at law and next of kin of Tom W. Garrett and Nellie M. Garrett, both deceased.


