To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Jordan Jones, of Shelby County, Alabama,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Jordan Jones, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the West half of the North East quarter of Section twenty nine the South East quarter of the North East quarter, of Section thirty two, the West half of the South West quarter of Section twenty two, and the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section twenty seven, in Township twenty one, of Range two, West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing two hundred, and forty acres, and ten six, and three fourths hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Jordan Jones,

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

Jordan Jones,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Jordan Jones,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
