

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SHONEY'S SOUTH, INC.

On November 3, 1976, at 1:30 p.m., a special meeting of the Board of Directors of Shoney's South, Inc., was held at the offices of the corporation pursuant to waiver of notice signed by all directors.

Mr. James H. Prentiss, III acted as Chairman of the meeting and Mr. Morris Kriger acted as Secretary. The Chairman stated that the corporation had received a commitment from the Central Bank of Birmingham, in Birmingham, Alabama, to loan to the corporation \$1,500,000.00 in order to finance three Hungry Fisherman Restaurants to be located in River Chase, Alabama, Stone Mountain, Georgia, and Marietta, Georgia. The Chairman noted that the loan would be secured by the land and buildings of the two Hungry Fisherman Restaurants in Atlanta and the Hungry Fisherman Restaurant located in Birmingham, Alabama. After due discussion, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED that the President of Shoney's South, Inc.

James H. Prentiss, III or the Vice President of Shoney's

South, Inc., W. Terry Young, shall be, and hereby is, authorized

to execute all necessary documents in order to obtain a

loan in the principal amount of \$1,500,000.00 from the

Central Bank of Birmingham, Birmingham, Alabama; said

loan to be secured by the real property and structures

of the two Hungry Fisherman Restaurants located in

Atlanta, Georgia, and the Hungry Fisherman Restaurant

located in Birmingham, Alabama.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion made, duly seconded and unanimously passed, the meeting was adjourned.
