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THIS RELEASE, Made this <u>22nd</u>day of <u>howender</u>, A.D., 1976, between SEABOARD COAST LINE RAILROAD COMPANY, a Virginia corporation, hereinafter called "Grantor" and WILLIAM L. COLE and EUGENE BRIDGERS, JR., mailing address P. O. Box 30140, Birmingham, Alabama, 35222, hereinafter called "Grantee", WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by deed dated November 14, 1975, recorded in Official Recordance Book 295, Page 824, public records of Shelby County, Alabama, Grantor conveyed to Grantee, those certain tracts or parcels of land situate, lying and being at Pelham, County of Shelby, State of Alabama, as particularly described in said deed to which reference is hereby made; and

NOW THEREFORE, Grantor, for and in consideration of the premises and of One Dollar to it paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby recognizes that all conditions in said deed pertaining to the construction of a wholesale lumber business operation on the parcels of land conveyed by said deed have been fully met by Grantee, all does hereby confirm the title of Grantee to said parcels of land, free from all conditions set forth in the above quoted clause.
