My name is Wilma Holcombe Davis, and I reside at 203 South Norton Street, Sylacauga, Alabama. I am one and the same person as the grantee on those certain deeds recorded in Deed Book 142, page 499, and Deed Book 140, page 466, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama. My father's name was William E. Holcombe, and he died in January of 1937. My father's first wife was Eva L. Holcombe, and she died without a last will and testament in 1901. In addition to my father, Eva L. Holcombe left surviving her as sole heirs and next of kin at law, the following named children, Lapsley Holcombe, Edwin Holcombe, Robert Holcombe and Bessie Holcombe, who was later known as Mrs. Bessie Dunnam. Robert Holcombe died in 1932 without a last will and testament, and left surviving him his widow, Mrs. Ruth Holcombe, and one child, Robbie W. Holcombe.
