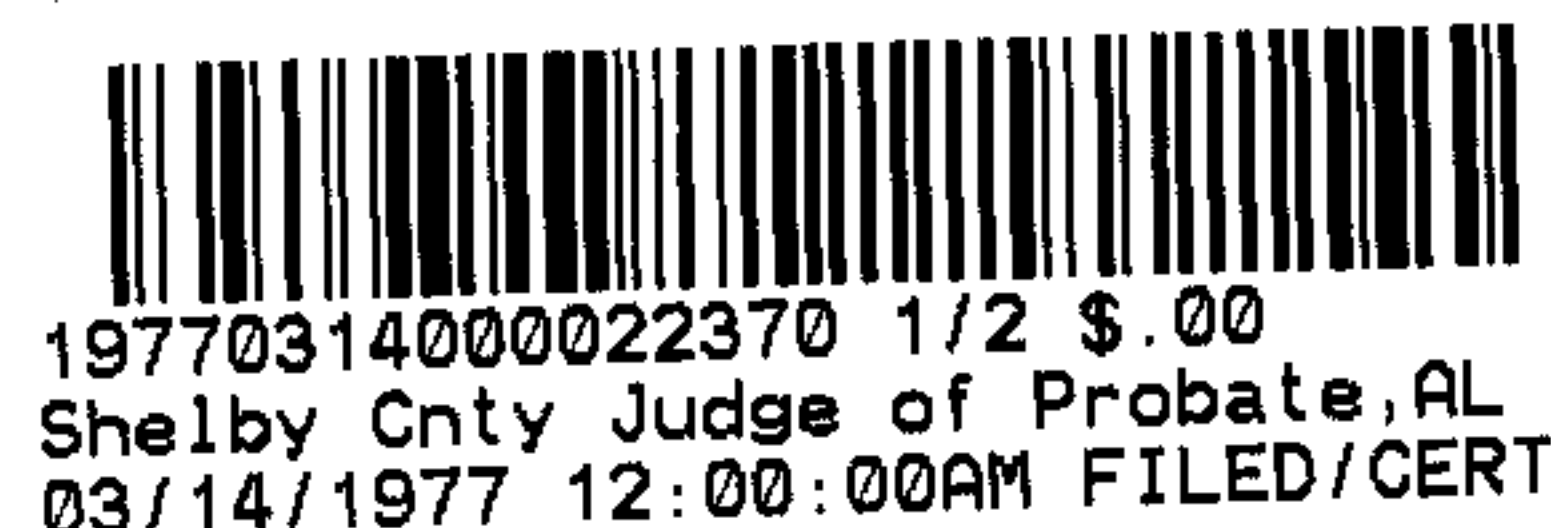

do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Claude L. Crim and Berenice Crim

the following described real estate, to-wit: Begin at the Northeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 24, Range 13 East and run thence West along the
North line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ section a distance of 280 yards, more or less, to the
corner of Marvel Fletcher lands; thence run South, along an East line of
said Marvel Fletcher lands a distance of 70 yards; thence run East, along
a North line of said Marvel Fletcher lands a distance of 70 yards; thence
run South, along an East line of Marvel Fletcher lands, a distance of 300
